

Please see below details of an incident that occurred at a property in Dyrham yesterday, 20th November. Please be on the lookout in case the vehicle and its occupants return.

Yesterday, (20.11.18), a stranger walked into the residents' kitchen without knocking or ringing the bell, and said he was looking for his dog, which had jumped out of his van while he was working on trees "down the road".

The man was 6 feet tall, 35-45 years old, well built, wearing jeans and a light blue sweatshirt. The resident escorted him off the premises and recorded the registration of his car - JW56 PCW – which was a light metallic coloured SUV. There was also an unseen accomplice down Poplar Lane. The National Trust had nobody working on their trees in that location.

The resident reported the incident to the police. The vehicle appears to have been of interest to the police already.
